Youth classes

Youth competitors are not allowed to show a stallion. On NRHA USA approved shows every Youth competitor, who wants to enter a Non –Pro class, must have a Non Pro declaration as well and must fulfill the Non Pro regulations. The horse must be registered either on the Youth rider or on a direct family member.

Non Pro classes

Each Non Pro must have a valid Non Pro Declaration . The Non Pro Status will be written on your Membership Card. The horse must be registered either on the name of the Non Pro rider or on an immediate family member. Each Non Pro, who rides a horse, that is owned by an immediate family member, must show up with an Immediate Family Form.

Competition License

Each horse must be registered by the NRHA USA and gets a Competition License. Each horse owner must be a current member of the NRHA USA.

During a horse show you only can get a membership for the rider and the owner. A Competition License cannot be issued during the event.

Open classes

As well the rider, as the owner of the horse, must show up with a valid NRHA USA membership card and the horse must have a Competition License USA.

The organiser has to make a copy of each document (membership card, Non Pro declaration, Competition License, etc.) and to list it with the final settlement with NRHA USA. Therefore it is absolutely necessary, that each competitor encloses all the necessary papers with his enrollment.
